DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY TOPIC — YEAR 2

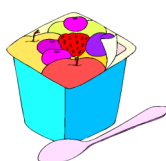
As part of our Design and Technology topic about healthy eating, Year 2 will be making a fruit salad on Monday 12th March. Please can you provide your child with the following:

LOCAL NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICE ADVICE

We have received the following advice for local residents from our PCSO Tracey Armes:

During the month of January 2018 the team saw 11 burglaries reported across Seven Kings Ward. Of the 11 reported to police 5 were within business premises. A number of the burglaries took place overnight with 2 reported to have taken place either early or late evening. Can we ask all residents to ensure that they double lock all window & doors, front & back, when in or out of the premises, it only takes a few minutes to get through a door that is NOT double locked. The ward has also seen a rise in Theft of Motor Vehicles via burglary; can you please ensure if you have a keyless car please put the fob into a metal tin/ security pouch to assist in blocking the signal. Also, if you own a high value car please ensure you do not leave keys on view, or in obvious places such as hallways, kitchens and living areas. It maybe an idea to take them upstairs with you at night time.

BMW cars appear to be a target at the moment across the ward, not only are they being stolen, but parts are being taken from them including steering wheels and dashboards, please take a look at security for your car.
