

Some of our Year 1 and Year 3 children took part in 'Learn to Ride' and 'Bikeability Level 1' with Cycle confident instructors last week. They all put in a great effort with lots of them learning to ride without stabilisers and learning how to use gears and brakes

We loved hearing her responses and found her story incredibly inspiring. Our virtual meeting with Maya helped us build empathy for refugees all around the world and it also helped


