
It's Our Birthday!

Who Is Britain's New King?



The UK has a new monarch, following the death of his mother, Queen Elizabeth II. From now on,

the Queen's eldest son will be known as King Charles III. His wife, Camilla, becomes the Queen Consort, which is a term used for the partner of the King.

Prior to her funeral, the Queen's coffin was taken to Parliament's Westminster Hall, where tens of thousands of people queued to pay their respects. The queue reached about 5 miles long with wait times of up to 16 hours.
