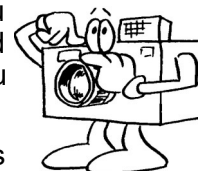
If your child has borrowed any clothing from school can you please make sure it is returned promptly. Thank you.



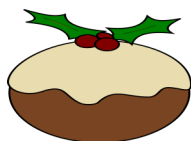
SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS
