## Message from the Headteacher

Today, the school community mourns the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. She was admired and respected by so many across the world.

Many of our Barley Lane community members may wish to pay their respects and own tributes to the Queen. Books of condolence and floral tribute sites have opened at <u>six locations</u> across Redbridge, our nearest being Goodmayes Library. A special vigil will be held at the Library at 6pm next Wednesday.

At school, we held a special assembly for children in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 this morning to mark the occasion. We celebrated the Queen's life and her remarkable contribution to society, discussed what has happened this week and what will happen next. We briefly explored what is meant by grief and public mourning, as the children will be exposed to TV and newspaper articles in coming days. We acknowledged that regardless of whether we feel sad, confused or no different, all of feelings are valid and we should talk and ask questions if we need to explore them.

We are currently awaiting confirmation of the funeral date and will update parents in advance of any school closure. In the meantime, school will open as normal next Monday.
