Winning entries will be used in REWT publications and training programmes.

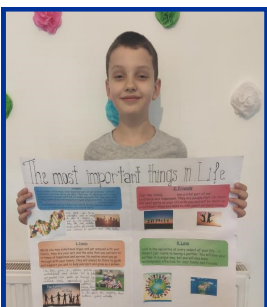
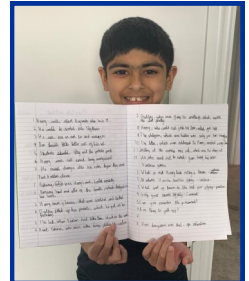

It's also fantastic to see so many of the children and parents emailing our year group inboxes with their work for feedback.

We hope that the children have enjoyed speaking to their teachers on the phone this week. Our teachers certainly enjoyed it! We look forward to the next round of phone calls.



Our school Zoom security setup and training is complete, and **zoom** we have already begun using the platform for SEND meetings with families and external agencies. We're looking forward to seeing your children next week for some class Zooms. Log-in details for each session were sent to parents yesterday. Our **Home Learning** webpages have been attracting lots of users in June:

2198 unique users visited the site this month. Most were from the UK, but some were from other countries including the US, India, Japan, Finland, Indonesia, South Africa, UAE, Egypt, Ireland, New Zealand and Qatar!

On average, each user came back **3** times, visiting a total of **23,588** Barley Lane pages in June!

There were **15,580** Home Learning page views this month!

Year 4 Home Learning has come out on top with 1547 page views this month, **Year 2** in second place with 1448, followed by **Year 5** with 1426!



Timestable Rockstars



It has been fantastic to see how many children are still logging into Timestable Rockstars and trying to improve their speed and fluency. We have had several tight battles between year groups recently and Year 3 have performed particularly well against the older year groups. Returning to School - The Educational Psychology Service

For many, returning to school or college may feel like a relief, a sense of normality returning after a period of significant change. Many young people in Redbridge will have managed this change well even finding opportunities for growth and development. However, we envisage that there will also be many struggling with the adverse effects of the Covid-19 Public Health Crisis and currently finding themselves worried and anxious about the return to school. When educational settings re-open there may be pressure to return to 'normal' and to 'catch up' on learning that did not occur in school. You might find yourself being caught up in a rush toward these goals. The EPS advocates instead for a period of transition, as educational placements grow back from very small numbers of pupils and to welcoming its full cohort in school.

Parents, Carers and Pupils will have had many different experiences of the lockdown period. There will have been experiences of connection with family, time for fun and new opportunities, alongside experiences of living with stress and anxiety due to threats to health and financial stability, and of loss in all its different forms. For many, home has become the safe place and they have learnt that meeting friends and going out risks infection and illness.



Some children returning to school may be worried about catching the virus and becoming ill or transmitting it to vulnerable family members.

The Educational Psychology Service can offer support to parents and children who may need it on their return to school in the following ways:
