Redbridge 11 Plus

When to register for the Redbridge 11 Plus selection test

11 Plus registration for Ilford County High School for boys and Woodford County High School for girls starting September 2019 will open on Tuesday 1 May 2018 and will close at 5pm on Wednesday 27 June 2018. You can only register for the 11 Plus test between the registration opening and closing dates. It is not possible to register before or after these dates.

Where the tests are taken

Your child is expected to sit the test at the grammar school you most want them to attend.

Date of the 11 plus selection test

Saturday 15 September 2018

Travel arrangements and parking for open evenings and test day

There will be no parking facilities available at either school site, except for those who have displayed a disabled badge.

Please use public transport, but if you are driving be respectful of the residents around the schools. Please make suitable travel arrangements to avoid parking issues on these dates.


UNIFORM SALE/ DROP IN
